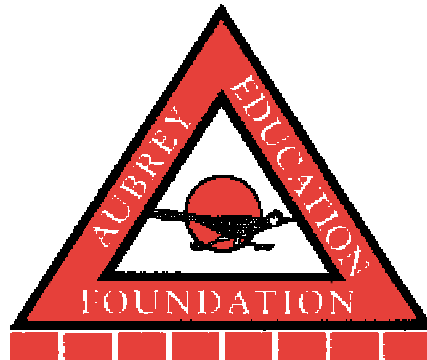


2008 Senior Scholarship Application
